

Separation and disposal of resources

Empty bottles

- Separate according to color and place in the collection site containers.
- White containers...Transparent (white) bottles
- Brown containers...Brown bottles
- Blue containers...Other colored bottles
- ※ Bottles that will be collected are limited to those used for beverages and condiments.
- ※ Please take beer and sake bottles to liquor and other stores for recycling.



Bottles that will not be collected ● Bottles for uses other than beverages (cosmetic bottles etc.) are classed as glass.

Newspapers, magazines (scrap paper), cardboard

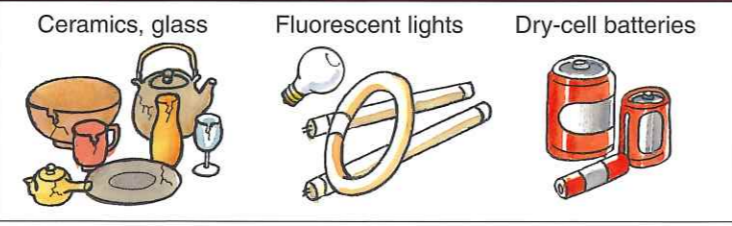
- Separate by type and place in the collection site.
- Remove staples, adhesive tape etc., from newspapers, magazines (scrap paper) and cardboard and then tie using white string.
- Dispose of advertising inserts together with newspapers.
- Recycle candy and tissue boxes as well.



Materials that will not be collected ● Photographs, carbon paper, cardboard cylinders from plastic wrap etc. should be disposed of as burnable garbage.

Ceramics, glass, fluorescent lights, dry-cell batteries

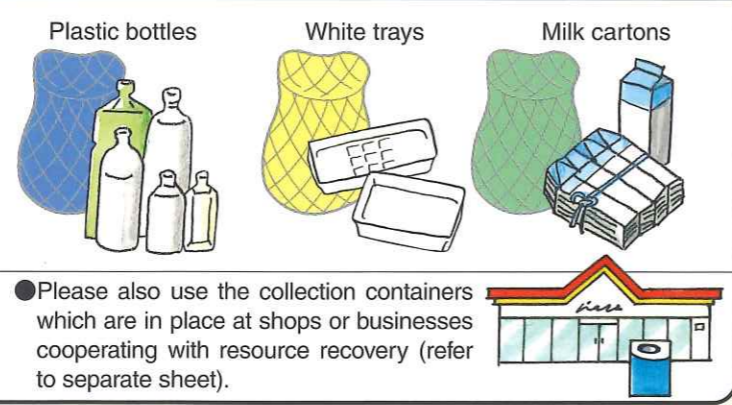
- Place in collection site containers according to type.
- ※ Waste types are displayed on containers.



Ceramics Bowls, plant pots etc.
Fluorescent lights Fluorescent light, light bulbs (dispose of without breaking)
Glass Aquariums, cosmetic bottles, glass cups, plate glass etc.
Dry-cell batteries Dry-cell batteries (rechargeable and button batteries should be taken to the distributor and car batteries should be taken to automobile service centers for example.)

Plastic bottles, white trays, milk cartons

- Place in the nets provided.
- Wash lightly and remove excess water before disposal.
- Plastic bottle caps should be disposed of as burnable garbage.
- Colored trays and trays with designs should be disposed of as burnable garbage.
- Open up milk cartons before disposal.
- These items will be collected on resource collection days.

Burnable garbage

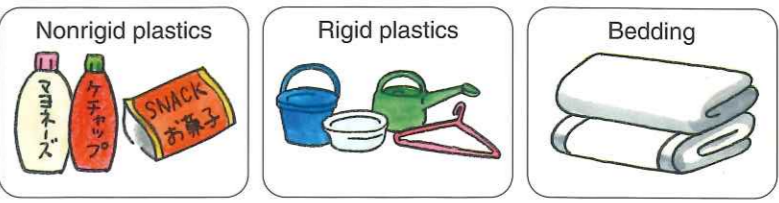
- Place in the specified garbage bags and place in the collection site.
- Ensure that excess water has been removed from raw garbage before disposal.
- There are 4 sizes of specified garbage bags. (20L, 30L, 45L, 70L)



※ Old specified garbage bags that have already been purchased can be used until they run out.

● Garbage that cannot be placed in collection site

Conventional burnable garbage



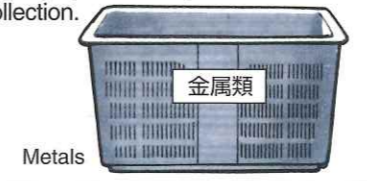
All the above garbage is designated burnable garbage.

Large amounts of garbage from moving, cleaning etc;
Large items of garbage that will not fit into the specified garbage bags; and
Large items of furniture such as drawer chests, sofas, beds etc.

Nonburnable garbage

- Waste metal
- Household electrical appliances (Exclusive of televisions, refrigerators/freezers, washing machines, air conditioners, computers)
- ※ For items that do not fit into the black containers or for large amounts of these varieties please make arrangements to transport this garbage to your nearest processing facility.
- ※ For aluminium cans please cooperate as much as possible with group collection.



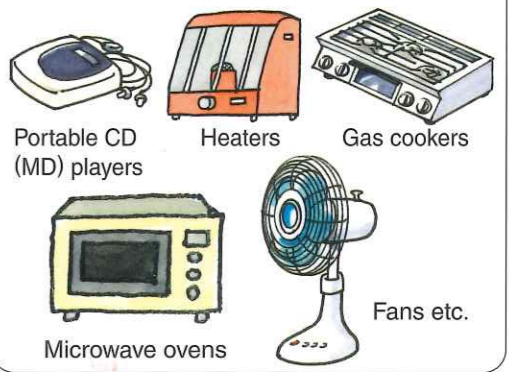
- Spray cans
- Disposable lighters



Empty cans and other waste metal



Household electrical appliances which will fit into the containers



Used spray cans: Remove all the contents from the can and open a whole in the can taking care to avoid sparks and open flames.
Used disposable lighters: Dispose of after all lighter fluid has been used.

● Large amounts of garbage from moving, cleaning etc;
Bicycles, large steel furniture etc.

● 4 categories of appliances: Televisions, refrigerators/freezers, washing machines, air conditioners
